



Little detectives: Who am I?

Through this activity, the students work collaboratively to develop a series of clues relating to a collection of animal pictures which have been placed on the mat.

Aims: This activity is designed to encourage the children to use the acquired vocabulary to read words, and form sentences.

Reference to the syllabus: Demonstrates enjoyment and motivation to participate in writing activities and the ability to use the acquired vocabulary in writing. Begin to read confidently with fluency, accuracy and expression.

Progress:

Age Group: 7/8 year olds

The teacher prepares a set of cards containing various animal pictures.

In pairs, the children pick a picture and write a clue on a card. Then the cards with the clues are placed in a box.

The students pick a card from the box, read the clue and guess which animal it is.

Then they have to programme the bot and direct it to the tile with the correct picture.

What type of resource is this?

Floor robots like bee-bots or blue-bots.

Resources needed: Floor robots mat, flashcards with pictures, plain flashcards to write on.

This activity helps the children to think and build simple sentences on a particular picture.
