

Sentence building

This activity is designed to encourage the children to read words, and form sentences.

The children will learn of the conventions of writing including capitalization, punctuation, and good sentence construction.

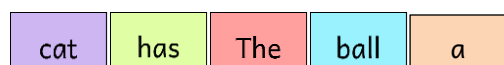
Aims: To form simple sentences.

Reference to the syllabus: Begin to show understanding of sentence structure. Use basic sentence structure; subject-verb-object sentences.

Progress:

Age Group: 6/7 year olds

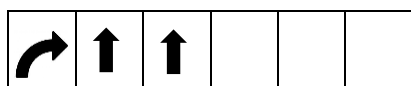
The children are given a set of flashcards.



In pairs, the children have to read the given set of words.

Then they have to put the cards in order to form a sentence.

Then they have to instruct the bot on to the words in order to form a sentence. Before programming the blue-bot they can draw the directions on a wipe-clean card. eg

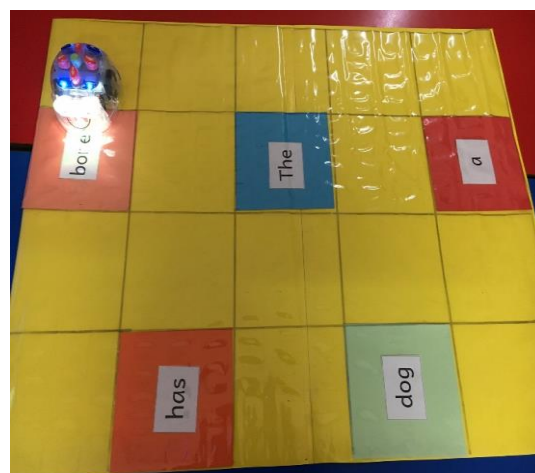


Repeat process as required.

What type of resource is this?

Floor robots like bee-bots or blue-bots.

Resources needed: Floor robots mat, flashcards with pictures, flashcards with words. Laminated cards with grids.

This activity helps the children build simple sentences paying particular attention to the subject-verb-object order. It can also be adapted to word building according to the learner's level.
